The person chartering the boat is responsible for dividing up the costs with their passengers. The boat captain reserves the right to limit freight. The boat can carry up to 4 passengers but if there is freight, the number goes down depending on the amount of freight. Freight should be boxed appropriately for water spray or weather conditions as deck is open.

People travelling on Band Business and/or ITHA need to fax in a purchase order for their trip to 914-3406.

All payments should be made via cheque or e transfer to finance@mdtc.ca. **The boat does not take cash.** Please make arrangements to pay prior to trip.

If the fisheries boat is also going out for fisheries business, the cost is 50% of what it would normally be. (i.e. if the boat is going out from Gilford to drop off mussels and on the way back a member wants to come in with groceries – the cost for the member would be 75.00.)

There is a 25.00 an hour waiting charge if the skipper needs to wait for someone. (i.e. if a member hires the boat to go from Gilford to Port McNeill to grocery shop and then runs up to shop taking 2 hours, the total charge for the charter is 200.00 which includes there and back) If the wait is over 6 hours then it is considered a new charter.
